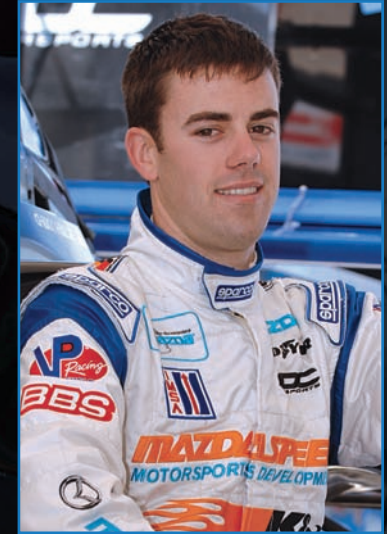


Joel Miller

Joel Miller started his racing career in 1997 with karting in Southern California. He won many local and regional championships en route to being noticed by factory teams out of Europe. Joel became a factory driver for Tony Kart and captured the 2006 North American championship in the ICA division. His Formula car career started in 2003 with Formula Fords, but a lack of funds limited his progression. In 2007 Joel won the Skip Barber National Series with 5 wins and 10 podiums in 14 starts, and was selected for the Team USA Scholarship which allowed him to compete in England during the off-season. His success propels him to the Pro Mazda Championship in 2008 with support from the Mazda Driver Development Program. Joel is looking forward to the 2008 Pro Mazda season with JDC Motorsports and K&N.
